Maha Hussain, M.D., FACP

Dr. Maha Hussain was born and raised in Baghdad, Iraq. She is a graduate of Baghdad Medical College (Baghdad University) and has completed training in Internal Medicine and Medical Oncology at Wayne State University in Detroit, Michigan.

Currently Dr. Hussain is a Professor of Medicine and Urology at the University of Michigan and a member of the UM Comprehensive Cancer Center, in Ann Arbor, Michigan.

She is nationally and internationally recognized for her clinical and research expertise in the area of genitourinary-oncology. She is a fellow of the American College of Physicians and serves in different capacities in several national professional and research organizations such as the American Society of Clinical Oncology and the Southwest Oncology Group. In addition, she is a member of the Oncology Drugs Advisory Committee (ODAC) of the Food and Drug Administration (FDA). Dr. Hussain has published extensively as well as lectured locally, nationally and internationally.

Dr. Hussain has been advocating for human rights, democracy, women rights and equality for the people of Iraq and has publicly spoken for this cause. She is a member and past president of the Iraqi Forum for Democracy, she is also a founding member of the Women for Free Iraq and a current member of the Women Alliance for Democratic Iraq.
